Arkansas City juvenile victim of battery on Trick or Treat Night

Four juveniles in Halloween costumes suspected; police seek information

ARKANSAS CITY, Kan. (October 29, 2015) — A 16-year-old juvenile male was the victim of battery on Monday night during Trick or Treat activities in Arkansas City.

Police were dispatched about 8:10 p.m. to the intersection of Radio Lane and Summit Street for the battery report. They contacted the alleged victim at that location.

He said that while he was walking in the 300 block of Random Road, three to four unknown suspects wearing Halloween costumes punched and kicked him. The suspects then left the area.

The victim was treated by the Arkansas City Fire-EMS Department and transported to South Central Kansas Medical Center for further evaluation.
