Ark City residents arrested after alleged domestic disturbance

Coday, Wehrle remain in jail Tuesday for domestic battery, on other charges

ARKANSAS CITY, Kan. (November 3, 2015) — Two Arkansas City residents were arrested Monday afternoon after an alleged domestic disturbance at 1214 South B St.

Johnathon Dale Coday, 24, was arrested on suspicion of battery-domestic violence, criminal damage to property and disorderly conduct. He was transported to and booked into the Cowley County Jail in Winfield in lieu of \$3,000 bond through Cowley County District Court in Arkansas City.

Amber Lynn Wehrle, 27, was arrested on suspicion of aggravated battery-domestic violence. She was transported to and booked into the county jail in lieu of \$10,000 bond through Ark City district court.

Both Coday and Wehrle remained in custody at the time of this report.

Officers were dispatched about 1:25 p.m. for a report of a domestic disturbance on South B Street.

They contacted Coday and Wehrle, and learned that they had been in a fight during which both had sustained injuries. Wehrle is suspected to have struck Coday with a frying pan, injuring his left arm.

Coday, who is homeless, is suspected to have damaged items in the residence, as well.

Both Coday and Wehrle were checked at the scene, but declined medical treatment.

A defendant's guilt or innocence is to be determined by a court of law.
